

Area 15 Regional Planning Commission Title VI Notice to the Public

The Area 15 Regional Planning Commission hereby gives notice to the public public notice that it is the policy of the planning commission to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and all related statutes and regulations. Title VI and related statutes and regulations provide that no person shall on the ground of race, color, national origin, gender, age or disability be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance.

Any person who believes that they are being denied participation in a project, being denied benefits of a program, or otherwise being discriminated against because of race, color, national origin, gender, age, or disability have the right to file a Title VI Complaint. Any such complaint must be submitted using the Title VI Complaint Form and mailed to the Title VI Compliance Officer no later than 180 days after the alleged discrimination.
