 - Wapello County Kirksville Road:** Applying for \$1,200,000 for Kirksville road from US 63/IA163 north to Kirksville NCL. Project will be programmed in FY25.
 - Wapello County Monroe-Wapello Road:** Applying for \$1,500,000 for Monroe-Wapello Road from CP railroad tracks to US 34. Project will be programmed in FY25.
 - Van Buren County J40:** Originally applied and awarded \$1,520,000 to resurface J40 from Davis CL to V64. Applying for Additional \$351,607 in funding due to increased costs. Project will remain in FY23.

Call to Order. Ryne called the meeting to order at 10:05am.

Action Items

Review of the minutes. Sedivec made a motion to approve the minutes from June 8th, 2022 , Allison seconded the motion. All present voted aye; motion approved.

2023 TIP Revisions

Fairfield – Amendment: Requested to Remove State Bridge SWAP funding from project and add federal bridge funds to US 34/Burlington Avenue project over West Crow Creek. Kukla explained the change is due to IJJA and IDOT being unable to maintain SWAP for many programs but is an amendment since adding federal funding.

Allison made a motion to approve, Heintz seconded the motion. All present voted aye; motion approved.

IDNR – Amendment: Requested to add \$110,800 in FRT funds to replace a storage and maintenance building at Bluff Creek OHV park, match will be provided by special ATV fund.

IDNR – Amendment: Requested to add \$213, 812 in FRT funds to construct additional parking for large vehicles at Bluff Creek OHV park, match will come from ATV registration fund.

Allison made a motion to approve both IDNR amendments at Bluff Creek, Murphy seconded the motion. All present voted aye.

Oskaloosa – Administrative Modification: Requested to move South 7th Street project from FY24 to FY23 due to project being ready. Kukla noted that RPA currently does not need to adjust other projects, move or remove funds to allow project to move forward to allow but later may have to make adjustments. Skalberg asked for what size projects. Kukla said we would just have to ask IDOT.

Heintz made a motion to approve moving Oskaloosa 7th Street forward, Skalberg seconded the motion. All present voted aye.

Other

Status on active STBG/SWAP and TAP projects.

Skalberg indicated he planned to submit an STBG application in the spring for FY24 or 25 to replace the project Wapello County dropped last year.
